In support of the New Hampshire Government led efforts to reduce the opportunities for viral transmission, Sentinel has initiated various preventative measures. We are working with state and local agencies regarding the health and safety of campers and we are following best practices recommended by Health officials for the safety of all campers and camp employees.

What makes Sentinel unique:

- Sentinel is an essential choice for families, offering childcare through overnight and day camp. Sentinel offers hope in uncertainty. In person safe interaction is important to the development of children.
- Located on 629 acres and a mile of water frontage, we provide a place for campers to spread out and enjoy fresh air.
- The majority of our campers and staff are local.

What we are doing:

- Increased the frequency of cleaning activities through the campus with priority placed on areas anticipated to have elevated risks for viral contact.
- Added additional hand sanitizing stations throughout the camp.
- Set up an isolated area for sick campers.
- Displaying proper handwashing hygiene posters in key areas throughout the camp.
- Coordinating with housekeeping staff to ensure high traffic areas are frequently maintained and ensuring cleaning crews are following the best practices.
- Reducing cabin sizes and camper enrollment for sleeping.
- Campers screened upon arrival and temperature checks throughout the week.

What you can do:

The most effective ways to protect yourself and others against COVID-19 are to:

- frequently wash/sanitize your hands for at least 20 seconds each time.
- cover your cough with the bend of elbow or tissue.
- maintain a distance of at least six feet from people who are coughing or sneezing.
- stay at home if you are sick.
- avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- avoid close contact with people who are sick.
